It was a full one day programme that was focused to all aspect of Hernia management with recent development and was meant for the PG students and Residents.

The Annual Conference of ASI, '79th ASICON 2019' was being organised and hosted by the ASI, Odisha state chapter. From 18th to 21st Dec. 2019 at IMS & SUM Hospital Bhubaneswar. 

OSASICON 2020 REPORT

The 35^{th.} Annual conference of Association of Surgeons of India, OSASICON 2020 was conducted on a virtual platform due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. Dr. C.R.Das, senior member & past GC member of ASI was the Convenor. Dr. B. B. Mishra, Professor & Head of Department of Surgery, SCB Medical College Cuttack and GC member of ASI, was the organising Chairman, Dr. Sreejoy Patnaik, GC member of ASI and Dr. Sanjay Kumar Giri, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Plastic surgery & Burn, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, and Joint Secretary, ASI, Odisha was the organising Secretary. CLIRNET was the Digital partner, and Shanti Memorial Hospital, Cuttack provided the base station. 402 numbers of surgeons from different places Odisha and some from across India registered for the conference. Renowned Surgeons from India and Odisha attended as faculties. The Medical Council of India awarded 8 credit hours for the benefit of delegates. The detail programme is attached herewith.

The first day with three sessions was fully dedicated for the Post graduate students of surgery from all over the state. The first session was a PG Paper competition, where Prof.P.K.Hota, Prof.Diptendu Sarkar and Prof. Debajyoti Mohanty were the judges. Dr.Vikram VS from AIIMS BBSR secured the first position, Dr.Navya Teza from IMS & SUM second, and Dr.Prakharanshu from SCBMCH & Dr.Manita Tamang from MKCG both secured third position. The second session was a PG Quiz competition. Teams from seven medical colleges participated, which was conducted by Prof.P.K.Sahoo from IMS & SUM Hospital, Addl.Prof.P.K.Sasmal from AIIMS, Bhuabaneswar, and Prof.Pankaj Kumar. The team from VIMSAR Dr.Srimanta Padhi & Dr.Debashree Maharana stood first, from IMS & SUM Hospital Dr.Vishnu TeJa & Dr. TeJaswi Mishra Stood second, and from KIMS Dr.Harsh Bhomaj & Dr.Prathmesh Mishra stood third. The third session was a PG Master Class where six clinical cases were presented by six students. Dr.Sanjay Giri was the coordinator. Dr.Ashis Sahu from SCBMCH & Dr.Srikanth Gorre from IMS & SUM combinely stood first, Dr.Kritikalpa Behera from MKCG stood second, and Dr. K.B.Hassan from VIMSAR Stood third.

On 14th. Nov. morning at 9.30 AM the conference was **inaugurated**, the session was presided over by Prof. K.C. Mohapatra. **Dr. P.Raghu Ram**, Padma Shree awardees and President ASI was the chief Guest and Dr.Abhay N Dalvy Vice President ASI was the Guest of honour on the occasion. The chief guest inaugurated by lighting the divine lamp with background music of Saraswati bandana. Dr.B.B.Mishra the organising chairman welcomed the guests and delegates to this OSASICON 2020 on a virtual platform. The chief guest Dr.P.Raghu Ram addressed the surgeons with a strong message for working for the cause of the society. He advised the students and residents to work hard in order to update their knowledge and improve the skills to provide the best of the surgical treatments for the patients and have international excellence. Dr. K. C. Mohapatra the Chairman addressed the delegates. He detailed about the first ever virtual platform used for this conference due the current pandemic situation and requested all to take all possible advantage of this programme. Dr. Sibananda Mohanty gave a detail report of the academic activities of ASI, Odisha chapter during the last one year. The Scientific programme on day 2 started with **Guest lectures** by two eminent speakers Dr.Abhay N Dalvi, and Dr.Deepraj Bhandarkar. They talked on Tips for common G I procedures and Abdominal wall closure techniques respectively.

Next was an **Operative Video session**, where six operative videos were presented by Dr.Arun Mohanty, Dr.Sakti P Sahu, Dr.Amitav Jena, Dr.Sunil Agarwal, Dr.Prakash K Sasmal, and Dr.Sadanand Meher. This was followed by a **FREE PAPER SESSION** where Dr.Nihar R Pradhan, Dr.Santanu K Sahu, and Dr.Sanjay K Giri presented their expert paper of interest. These two programmes were co-ordinated by Dr.Sreejoy Patnaik and Dr.Sanjay Giri.

Then there was a **Panel discussion on 'Anastomotic Leak'**. Dr.Md.Ibrarullah was the moderator. Dr.Tushar K Mishra, Dr.Satya Prakash Ray Choudhury, and Dr.Harish Mishra took part as expert panellist in the discussion.

The Annual report was read by secretary. Amongst the important discussions made was the revamping of election process, where the election for EC was approved to be held every three years. The new elected members to EC for the year 2021-2023 was approved in the GB declared as follows: Dr.Bikash Ranjan Hota as Chairman for 2021, Dr.Sudhansu S Sutar as Hon.Secretary, Dr.Arun Mohanty, Dr.B.S.Bal, Dr.P.K.Sahu, Dr.A.G.Samal, Dr.R.N.Guru, as members to EC, and Dr.Prasant C Das, Editor, all for the year 2021-2023. The topic for the Rourkela fellowship was decided as 'Impact of Covid - 19 Pandemic on Surgical Practice,' which was proposed by Prof B.N.Mohanty. The next venue for OSASICON 2021 has been decided to be held at Kalinganagar to be organised by Dr.S.S.Sutar. Dr.Saroj K Raj was felicitated for a successful conducting of OSASICON 2019 at Balasore. A short celebration for felicitating the organising chairman and secretary of ASICON 2019 to Dr.C.R.Das and Dr.Sreejoy Patnaik was held. Different committees for Scientific, ASI SSS, Special donation drive, Membership drive were made. Meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the Hon.Secretary.

On 15th.**November** the programme started with **Orations** of ASI, Odisha chapter. The five orations awarded this year are as follows: Dr.G.S.Das Mohapatra award to Dr.Sreejoy Patnaik; Berhampur oration to Dr.P.Raghu Ram; Prof M.S.Khadanga oration to Dr.Sukriya Nayak; Bhubaneswar oration awarded to Dr.Rudra P Acharya; and Sushruta oration awarded to Major General Dr.P.K.Patnaik. Dr.C.R.Das, Dr.B.B.Mishra, and Dr.Sanjay Giri were the coordinator for this session. All the orators gave their presentations on virtual platform, including the read out of the Citations.
